Coral reefs are one of the most diverse ecosystems on the planet. Today campers will spend the day learning about this unique and beautiful place.

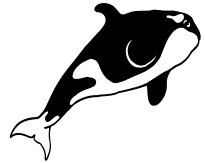
Thursday, November 11 * Dolphins and Sea Lions 1
