

- **Home School Program 6th – 8th grade:**
 - **Tuesday, February 13, 2007 – *Fish Fun*** – During this session students will learn about the similarities and differences between marine mammals such as sharks and fish.

- **Home School Program 9th – 12th grade:**
 - **Tuesday, February 13, 2007 – *Rainforest Adventure*** – Now students won't need to travel to Brazil or Madagascar to learn about the rainforest. This program will focus on the different animals that live in the rainforest; the unique and beautiful plants that create its surrounding and the need to preserve this world wonder.

In addition, this semester, Miami Seaquarium is introducing another program to its monthly education series, Scout Camping Adventure. From February 17 through 18, Girl Scouts from all of South Florida are welcome to join this camping opportunity where they will set up their tents next to Biscayne Bay and experience Miami Seaquarium in a different light and spend the night under the stars. Miami Seaquarium's trained education instructors will guide the young scouts around the park with activities that involve animal interaction, shows, science presentations and a nighttime scavenger hunt. Food and refreshments will be provided to all participating trooper.

Plus mothers and their children between the ages of two to five may enjoy “**Mommy and Me**” which is available starting Monday, February 12th from 10 a.m. to noon. During the program, mother and child will learn about different animals, from sea turtles to reptiles. The program will offer mothers and children the opportunity to interrelate and bond with these unique animals. The program begins Monday, February 12th and continues every third Monday of the months of March, April, and May.
