MIAMI - (August 26, 2019) – In 1955, Miami Seaquarium opened its doors for the first time to become the world’s largest marine attraction. On Saturday, Sept. 21, 14 lucky winners will be chosen at the Annual Passholder Appreciation Celebration and will receive a free annual pass to the park.
- **Annual Passholder Appreciation Celebration** – On Saturday, Sept. 21, annual passholders are invited to come out and enjoy an appreciation party in their honor. Guests will enjoy games, a prize wheel, costume character visits, ropes course, special trainer talks before the show and more surprises.
